JOB SUMMARY: Under the supervision of the IT System Administrator, the Gaming Technician will provide support for all Video Gaming Devices and Bingo computerized gaming equipment by providing efficient, effective, and timely service to the users of the Muckleshoot Indian Bingo.

MAJOR TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Support VGD Department by providing support for Player Terminals, BGC's, Kiosk's and associated computer workstations.
2. Troubleshoot computer and network related issues as required by VGD department.
3. Perform preventative maintenance on VGD and Bingo electronic related equipment.
4. Provide service and support for VGD devices as required.
5. Provide desktop support as required.
6. Run and terminate data connections.
7. Provide support for network equipment (routers, switches, and hubs.)
8. Performs other job-related duties as assigned.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING FOR POSITION (required and preferred): High school diploma or GED equivalent required. A+ certification required. Computer vocational schooling preferred. Minimum one year on the job experience providing hardware and software support. Preference given to individuals with at least 3 years experience supporting: Win9X, Windows NT, TCP/IP, wide and local area networks. Must have strong interpersonal skills to effectively interact and communicate with users, managers, subordinates and vendors. Must be able to work independently, with minimal supervision. Must be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
