- 3. Comply with the standard operating procedures of the department.
- 4. Keeps concession area stocked, clean, and presentable.
- 5. Cleans menus and busses tables as needed.
- 6. Responsible for handling of all payment transactions and handling of cash.
- 7. Help prepare any and all food items.
- 8. Makes coffee and keeps coffee station stocked.
- 9. Assists in maintaining and ensuring proper food quality.
- 10. Does daily calculating of receipts.
- 11. Takes food orders, and prepares and presents food items to guests as needed.
- 12. Delivers food to and from food outlets to guests.
- 13. Monitors inventory levels and notifies supervisor on replenishment needs.
- 14. Create, facilitate and maintain a positive work environment.
- 15. Smile and engage Guests and Employees with a positive professional demeanor.
