JOB TITLE: Emergency Medical Technician

POSITION REPORTS TO: Security Shift Manager

JOB SUMMARY: Provides emergency medical services to employees and guests with a high level of guest service; maintains supplies and equipment in a state of readiness; quickly assesses life-threatening emergencies and provides appropriate care.

MAJOR TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Responds to all medical assistance on Bingo property.
2. Assesses quickly all life threatening conditions, provide Basic Life Support.
3. Conducts daily inventory and inspections of equipment.
4. Provides basic health services for guests and employees until emergency response arrives.
5. Provides assistance with CPR and First Aid training as directed.
6. Maintains a written log of incidents involving guests or employees, and prepare additional detailed reports, as may be required.
7. Assesses the injured or sick individuals' need and if necessary, arranges for the dispatching of rescue units (Ambulance, helicopter, etc.)
8. Adheres to health, fire, and safety regulations, identifies potential safety hazards and reports such to the appropriate personnel.
9. Maintains a current awareness of facilities Disaster Plans and responds appropriately.
10. Remains current and up to date with training concerning emergency medicine and basic life support techniques.
11. Will perform Security Officer duties, as necessary.
12. Performs other job-related duties as assigned.

EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND TRAINING FOR POSITION (required and preferred): Must possess and maintain current CPR and Washington State Emergency Medical Technician - Basic (EMT-B) Certificate. Must have and maintain a valid Washington State Driver's License. High School diploma or GED equivalent required. Must have a minimum of 18 months current experience in an EMT role.

SPECIFIC SKILLS/KNOWLEDGE/ABILITIES REQUIRED FOR POSITION:

Knowledge of emergency medical procedures, first aid, CPR and basic life support techniques. Knowledge of security and risk policies and procedures. Ability to work in a fast-paced, busy, and somewhat stressful environment and maintain physical stamina, positive mental attitude while dealing effectively with guests, management, employees, and outside contacts while working under pressure and meeting deadlines. Ability to communicate effectively in a positive/upbeat fashion utilizing English; both in oral and written form. Ability to provide clear verbal and written instructions, prepare reports, and documents necessary to perform tasks. Demonstrated ability to investigate medical incidents, interview witnesses and draft legible, factual reports. Excellent guest service skills. Problem solving and conflict management skills. Excellent report writing skills.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Must be able to stand and/or walk for longer than 8 hours. Bend from the waist, crouch, stretch, kneel, climb, twist and crawl without restrictions. Must have the physical ability to access all areas of the property. Must be able to lift a minimum of fifty pounds (50 lbs.), able to push and /or pull two hundred pounds (200 lbs.).
